### MUSIC

*Andris Vecumnieks*

*About bright lights and dark abysses  
(Impressionism and Expressionism aesthetics) (45 min.)*

Lecture provides an insight into the eve of 19th-20th century's artistic styles of modernist era - Impressionism and Expressionism. Historical conditions of both styles emergence will be inspected as well as aesthetic guidelines, links to other art forms, characteristics and comparison of main features of impressionism and expressionism will be provided, also offering an age contextual assessment and brightest composer's guidelines portrayal. Number of participants - 15.

*Modalisation of tonality and tonalisation of modality.  
Tonality from sentence to the letter (45 min.)*

Lecture will offer more about the impressionist and expressionist musical expression usage specifics and their evolution in the context of Romanticism, Impressionism, Expressionism while focusing on the organization's fundamental principles of sound composition and musical modes especially when assessing implementation of vertical construction differences in different techniques of composition. *A child and musical sounds. Me and music.*

In the workshop would like to offer the musical moments, which can be used for music lessons to improve the development of children from birth to three years. Lessons for pre-school music teachers or teachers who work with children up to three years. Probably could be useful also for primary school teachers, because there will be some musical moments, which, by changing the degree of difficulty, it will be possible to offer also the primary children. Musical moments reveal the child's ability to participate and engage in lessons. These include musical movement, singing, listening to music, rhythm instruments, a game and a musical play. It is planned to practically collaborate with the music teachers. To provide the opportunity through the same experience to feel your body movement and music listening range of information. I think this is a great opportunity for teachers themselves express their ideas. Number of participants - 15

*Digital Audio Production Software (CUBASE PRO) and Educators*

This workshop will provide an overview of the fundamental principles of music production. It will explore the basic techniques of recording, mixing, processing, and editing of digital audio using one professional audio production software for PC: CUBASE of Steinberg. There are no specific musical or technical prerequisites for this workshop. This workshop will provide the tools that are necessary for educators in their jobs. Educators will learn an array of recording, editing, mixing techniques for use in music productions, creations, live music performance ect. Number of participants - 15.

**ARTS AND DESIGN**

*Angel workshop*

The figures of angels are usually associated with Christmas. They can be made from various materials, such as clay, porcelain, fabric, paper and other. During this workshop it will be possible to make the figures of angels using various techniques. This will allow the participants to learn new ways and forms of artistic expression. Number of participants is limited to 10 persons.

*Felting or “Soap and sponge in one product”*

Nowadays woolen felting or fulling is a very popular ancient art. Using this handicraft technology, you can make various jewelry, toys, clothing and various decorative items and practical things. There are two types which are used for wool felting: wet fulling and dry felting. Classical fulling is a wet wool fulling. Using this technique, dry carded wool is arranged in rows, thus wrapping a piece of soap. The product can be made in one or more colors, it can also create unusual ornaments which in a result of felting, become a peculiar art piece. Next, the product is wetted with soapy water and rubbed by hand in different directions until all fibers are completely joined to each other. The product is dried. Self-made soap-sponges are practically used, acting as a scrub-SPA ritual without leaving home. Great gift! Number of participants - 10 persons.

*“Scrapbooking” - inclusion in a book*

In English scrapbooking, in Latvian “skrapbukings”. Literal translation in Latvian: scrap - a cut and a book - that literally means "including in a book". Scrapbooking is a creative approach to designing photo albums and special greeting cards for a particular person. The workshop introduces this direction, the participants create a notebook with their own unique design. Number of participants - 10 persons.

*The Application of 3D Scanning in Clothing Virtual Fitting*

Scientific laboratory with handheld 3D scanner ArtecEva during which the process of human body scanning will be presented. Technology and design are two integral parts of any product. This is particularly important in the era of the 4th industrial revolution, when products are created for the whole world, which is full of different cultures, experiences, needs, and attitudes towards the sustainability of technological solutions. Another inseparable feature of this new era is co-design when the designer and the consumer are directly involved in the product development process together with the producer on-line in real time. The reality of nowadays is that many effective technological solutions exist one besides the other. The question is how to integrate them properly in order to provide an innovative basis for the implementation of 'co-design' paradigm. The case of such integration will be shown during the workshop, i.e. human body will be scanned with handheld 3D Artec Eva scanner and imported into Lectra CAD software for clothing Modaris 3D Fit. The example of the process will be provided for chemical protective clothing (CPC).
